# What is YPAC?

## Goals

- active participation of young people in the development of their Alpine surroundings and environment

- organized process for young people to form their opinions about issues of the Alpine Convention

- taking the responsibility by young people in the regional and European process of unification

# Set up of the YPAC

### Participants

In each member state one school for 16-19 year old is nominated to send delegation of four representatives.

YPAC is the simulation of the parliamentary work and students can take part in different roles:

- **delegates**: organized in four committees, discussing issues, preparing the resolutions.

- **committee presidents**: guide the preparations, lead the discussions in committees

- general presidents: run the whole organization

- press group: reporting, filming, taking pictures

# Set up of the YPAC

#### **Organization scheme**

- **planning:** team of teachers from each participant school choose the topic and discuss about the program of the next meeting

 preparations: led by general presidents and committee presidents over the internet communication (e – mail)

- **YPAC meeting**: every year on one of the participant schools

- <u>4th March 2008:</u> Arrival of the delegations and teachers in Maribor Meeting of the Committee presidents and Presidency
- <u>5<sup>th</sup> March 2008</u>: Official ceremony at the beginning of the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the YPAC Guided Tour of Maribor: Joining in Committees 1<sup>st</sup> Committee Meeting Committee Meeting with Experts Dinner and Evening Program
- <u>6<sup>th</sup> March 2008</u> 2<sup>nd</sup> Committee Meeting 1<sup>st</sup> General Assembly (Information-Assembly) Delegation Meeting 3<sup>rd</sup> Committee Meeting
- <u>7<sup>th</sup> March 2008</u> Lobbying General Assembly Closing Ceremony Evening program: Farewell party
- <u>8<sup>th</sup> March 2008</u> Excursion in Slovenia (Bled, Postojna Cave, the Cerknica Lake, Ljubljana
